Nestled in rolling Kettle Moraine topography sculpted by glaciers of the last ice age, and designed by Scott Miller, a former senior designer for Jack Nicklaus, the course plays to 7,005 yards with a par of 71.

GOLF FORMAT

- Five person teams consisting of one Wisconsin PGA professional and four amateurs
- Two best net Stableford scores on each hole
- Stableford Points: Eagle or better = 4, Birdie = 3, Par = 2, Bogey = 1, Double Bogey or worse = 0
- Amateurs receive 90% of their USGA Course Handicap
- Players are encouraged to pick up once they have reached double bogey but must hole out to count
- Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams
- Prizes awarded for two closest to the hole and two longest putt hole events
